Limited Warranty Coverage: Any failure due to defects in materials or workmanship occurring during the applicable warranty period, subject to the exclusions and limitations set forth in the Complete Warranty Policy & Procedures document. Limited warranty coverage applies only to STIHL products that are purchased from authorized STIHL dealers located in the United States and U.S. territories. Persons covered include only the original retail purchaser herein referred to as the “consumer.” Consumer use includes personal non-income producing household purposes. Professional use includes for profit or non-profit organizational, commercial, professional, or income producing purposes. The following respective limited warranty time periods apply only to STIHL battery-powered goods and related products:

Products & Warranty Time Periods

Warranty Time Periods begin on the date of purchase or date the product is placed into rental service. All rental use periods are 3 months.

Warranty Exclusions, Limitations and Rights (Battery Products)

The following are not covered by this limited warranty:

1. STIHL products purchased from and repairs or replacements and resulting failure performed by from anyone other than an authorized STIHL dealer located in the United States or U.S. territories.
2. Parts or components not supplied by STIHL or STIHL parts or components that have been modified and any resulting failure.
3. Any failure that results from accident, impact, abuse, misuse, neglect, mishandling, dulling of cutting edges, or failure to operate, maintain, update, or store the product in accordance with the information provided in the instruction manual supplied with the product.
4. Improper voltage for electric products and batteries that have been exposed to temperatures beyond those specified in the product’s instruction manual, batteries that have not been properly charged or batteries that have reached their useful life.
5. Normal adjustments, recommended maintenance, or storage preparation as described in the instruction manual supplied with the product.
6. Repairs made necessary by normal wear, improper maintenance, improper lubrication, improper storage, dirt, debris, abrasives, impact, moisture, water, water mineral deposits, rain, snow, freezing, rust, corrosion, varnish, or other similar conditions.
7. Any failure resulting from the use of improper tools (such as impact wrenches), incorrect assembly or improper repair procedures.
